Eligibility Criteria

1. Educational Qualification required will be Class 8 Pass and above.
2. Age limit shall be Minimum 21 Years during the date of publication of advertisement and Maximum Age limit is 37 years, relaxable for Government employee equal to the number of years they are in service, subject to a maximum of 5 years.
3. Documents required (mandatory).
 - a) Educational Qualification Certificate.
 - b) Birth Certificate
 - c) Indigenous Inhabitants Certificate, ST, BT Certificate.
 - d) Backward Tribe Certificate (if applicable).
 - e) Valid Driving License.
 - f) “No Objection Certificate” (NOC) from Head of Department with name and Official Seal, indicating the date of initial appointment of the candidate (if applicable).
 - g) Employment Exchange Registration Card.
 - h) 3 (Three) Passport size Photos.
4. 5 (five) years driving experience preferred.
5. Candidates will be assessed in the areas of General Knowledge, Driving Skills, Identification of Vehicle parts & Traffic Signals.
6. Application forms will be issued in the Directorate of SCERT, Nagaland, Kohima or can be downloaded from the SCERT website (scert.nagaland.gov.in) from 17th to 30th March, 2026
7. The filled forms should be submitted in person at the Directorate of SCERT, Nagaland, Kohima (Near Rüzühkhrie Government Higher Secondary School) on or before 07th April, 2026. Application form will not be accepted after the last date.
8. After due scrutiny of all relevant documents, list of the eligible candidates will be uploaded in the SCERT website (scert.nagaland.gov.in) and Office Notice Board on 10th April, 2026
