

Instructions for Filling up the Application Form:

- 1. This Application Form is for the Class VIII Government School Students appearing the National Means-Cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) Examination 2027.
- 2. The dully filled application form, admission card, photocopy of Class VII mark sheet, Scheduled Tribe /Caste Certificate must be submitted to the School Principal/Headmaster for verification and signature.
- 3. The Principal/Headmaster shall compile the applications of the students and submit them to the State Nodal Officer, NMMSS, SCERT, Nagaland, Kohima, on or before **31st August, 2026**. Applications received after the last date will not be accepted.
- 4. Incomplete or incorrectly filled application forms are liable to be rejected.
- 5. **Date of Examination:** 07th November, 2026 (Saturday).
- 6. **Reporting Time :** 9:00 A.M **Examination begins:** 9:30 A.M
- 7. Upon qualifying in the Examination, a scholarship of Rs. 1,000/- per month will be awarded from Class IX to XII.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

(for Government School Students Studying in Class VIII: Nagaland)

1. Ensure the Admission Card is not detached from the application form. The Roll Number will be issued by the State Nodal Officer, NMMSS, SCERT, Nagaland, Kohima.
2. Reach the Examination Centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination, and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. Do Not take calculators, mathematical & Physical tables, or any other kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. The examination will be conducted in two Sessions on the same day.
5. You have to take the examination in two parts:
 - (i) Part I - Mental Ability Test (MAT)
 - (ii) Part II - Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). The SAT consists of Science, Social Science and Mathematics.
- 6. Time for Part - I: 120 minutes and Part - II: 120 minutes.**
7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
8. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
9. All questions in the booklets are objective type.
10. Record your answers using a Ball Pen only.
11. During the examination, follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
12. Hand over your Question booklet before you leave the Examination Hall.
